School Readiness

We are delighted to see so many children return to school with the correct uniform and equipment. It is very important that children learn the value of being 'school ready' from an early age as it means they can then concentrate on their learning rather than worrying if they have the correct things in school.

Uniform

We expect children to wear the correct uniform each day. Our school uniform consists of;

- Grey or black trousers or skirt/ pinafore
- School logo jumper/
- White polo-shirt or shirt
- Black sensible shoes
- Grey or black tights/white or black socks.

PE Days

All children from year 1 upwards are expected to have a separate PE kit that consists of:

- House colour or white t-shirt (logo versions available)
- Black PE shorts
- Black plimsolls/daps or trainers

In the colder weather, plain track-suits are also acceptable. Children with long hair must tie it back in PE and earrings must be removed or taped.

We suggest that PE kits stay in school all week and can be taken home on Fridays to be washed and returned on Mondays. Children have timetabled PE sessions however at times additional sessions may take place.

School Equipment

We expect children to bring certain items with them to school each day. They must bring their school reading record, reading books and any other items indicated by their class teacher. It is not a requirement that children bring their own pencil cases, if they choose to do so it is at their own risk.

Healthy Snack Reminder



To encourage our children to make healthy choices we ask that they bring a healthy snack with them from Monday to Thursday. Alternatively, they may purchase a snack from our Healthy Tuck Shop which includes a wide range of fresh and dried fruit, raw vegetables and cereal bars at a cost of 20p per item. We would ask that children do not bring dairy products. Children are allowed crisps on a Friday, however this is limited to a maximum 30g bag. Also a reminder that water is the only drink allowed in school during lesson times

Headteachers Golden time

This will now be linked to attendance. Our schools minimum attendance target is 96.5%, but we aim for children to attend 100% of the time. At the start of each term, all children attaining 98% or more will receive headteachers golden time. This means that children who miss the target in one term, can still achieve it next term. 3 opportunities each year! At the end of the year ALL children with 98% or more OVER-ALL will receive a gift token.

Children with diagnosed illnesses will not be at a disadvantage as we will not take account of their required medical / hospital appointments.

Even if you have already given details to a primary school, you must apply for a place through the Admissions Team. This is the only way to apply; other forms or lists held by schools will not count.

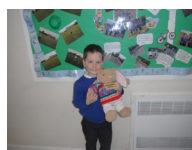
